### **Cultural mapping of the leisure activities of young people in Farum aged 16 -25**

On 17<sup>th</sup> May a workshop was held in Farum with the following participants:  
Lia Ghilardi, Henrik Sparre Ulrich, Henrik Haubro, Vivi Fahnøe, Hanne Jensen og Anne Beck.

We discussed that in our project in Farum we want to look at the social impact of culture on society, ie on our municipality.

We also discussed that it is a very important objective for our project to develop a good youth strategy in dialogue and cooperation with young people in Farum aged 16-25

We decided the following design for the cultural mapping:

1. Statistics and data gathering of the target group (Vivi)
2. Mapping of organisations in Farum (associations and institutions) (Anne)
3. Mapping of young people's priorities, their leisure activities, ways of looking at life in general and at Farum in particular (Hanne and Vivi)

#### **Ad 2:**

Anne will interview all cultural associations with young members (about 10)  
10 sports associations with young members  
The cultural institutions in the Kulturhus.  
The School for Young People, 2 youth clubs, 10<sup>th</sup> grade, Marie Kruse High School

They will be asked to describe the young people they work with, how they work with them, and about their experience with young people from ethnic minorities.

The associations will also be asked to describe values and how they spend the funding they receive from the municipality. Hopefully Anne will have finished the interviews by the middle of September.

#### **Ad 3:**

Vivi og Hanne will make a draft for interviewing about 100 young people from Farum. Hanne will do the interviewing from the beginning of July, and hopefully she will have finished them by the end of September.

The young people will be selected randomly in the library, the shopping centre and Farum Midtpunkt.

They will be asked about how they use their spare time, their leisure activities, their dreams and hopes, and how they see their lives in general.

When the mapping is completed, we can start analysing the results, and hopefully the analysis will result in the recommendation of an exciting youth strategy for Farum.
